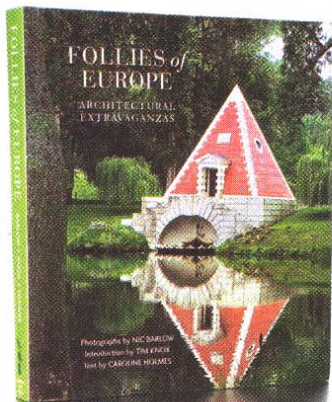
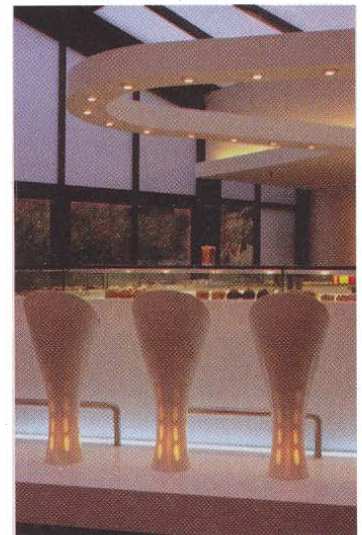
REMIX!
